The Wholesale Price Index (WPI) went up 2.2 percent in Esfand 1386. Showing the index point of 373.7, the WPI was 17.2 percent higher than the similar month in 1385.

On average, the Wholesale Price Index in 1386 increased 14.9 percent compared to previous year.

In Esfand, the food group index went up 2.5 percent, which was mainly attributed to the rise in the indices of "red meat", "chicken", "Iranian river fish", "Persian Gulf fish", "unprocessed milk", "rice (home produce)", "fresh fruits", "leaf vegetables", "exported pistachio", "date (domestic use)" and "tomato puree (domestic use)". In this group, the price of "Caspian Sea fish" and "egg" declined.

The beverages and tobacco group index increased 2.6 percent.

The crude materials, inedible, except fuels group index fell 1.3 percent.

The mineral fuels and related materials group index moved up 8.0 percent. This advance was mainly due to the rise in the index of "tar (domestic use)".

The increase in the indices of "P.V.C (domestic use)", "exported benzene", "exported propane", "exported butane", "exported ammonia", "liquid scouring" and "plastic in primary forms and synthetic rubbers" principally caused 2.0 percent advance in the group index of chemical and petrochemical products. In this group, the price of "methanol" moved down.

The 1.8 percent advance in the manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials group index was mainly attributed to the rise in the indices of "paper and cardboard", "hand-woven carpet and rug", "earthen brick", "iron sheets", "iron rod (home produce)", "copper wire", "exported copper", "aluminum ingot" and "pure aluminum".

The increase in the indices of "electric motors", "copper cable", "exported wire and cable" and "vans" mostly caused 1.3 percent advance in the group index of machinery and transport equipment.

The miscellaneous manufactured articles group index had no change.

In the special groups, the farm, livestock and fishing products group index and the building materials group index went up 2.9 percent and 4.1 percent, respectively.


